Introduction

British rulers wanted Indian youths to take military training so that their armed forces would get officers. British rulers in India, took this aim into account, opened University Training Crops, Later on in 1948 National Cadet Corps was established by Indian Government.

In 1960 to train more cadets in colleges and universities, NCC Rifle was established from Chinese invasion on India in 1962 in July 1963. NCC participation was made compulsory for students learning in colleges and universities.

In the same years i.e. 1962 Lok Seva Shikshan Mandal, Malkapur started 'Janata Kala-Vanijya Mahavidyalaya Malkapur' At the outset NCC was compulsory for every admitted student in our college. Nearly 800 to 900 students used to take NCC training in our college. In 1973 NCC training was made optional. Since then our college has been training 106 cadets every year. Our college company is attached to 13, Maharashtra Battalion Khamgaon, Dist – Buldana.

National cadet corps has its head quarter in New Delhi as Director General, NCC. The Director General of NCC commands 16 Deputy Director Generals in Maharashtra The office under this Directorate there are seven NCC Groups are working. In this 7 groups our NCC Unit occurs in Amravati Group. In Battalions and its head office Khamgaon. There are different companies working under 13 Maharashtra Battalions, Khamgaon. Our college NCC unit consists of 106 Cadets. Cadets are taking NCC training under our college company. Lt. P.N.Ladhe has been commanding college NCC Unit since 1999.

Admission Criterion

At the beginning of the academic session i.e. in June students have to go through Physical Fitness Test, Medical Test, Mental Test and psychological Test. Only then their admission is made confirmed. Throughout the session cadets undergo proper training besides this, they participate in social Activities and National Activities, Tree Plantation, Blood Donation, Relief Operations, Pulse Polio Drive, AIDS awareness campaign, National Integration Rally, etc.
